Meet up and camp at the Sommerville Valley Tourist Park at Storm King Dam, about 10km SE of Stanthorpe. The park is approximately 12km from the Girraween National Park, and many club members have stayed there previously because of the better facilities there. I have booked a Group Area for camping in the names of 'Trevor Davern' and alternately 'Redlands Bushwalkers'.

The Group Area is the first on the left as you drive into the park. Immediately adjacent to this area is a row of Cabins. I shall be there from Friday to Monday. You may book for whatever days you wish to stay, either camping or using a cabin. The fees are \$15 per night per person for camping, and \$70 per night for a cabin (for 2 people).
