

Rat-a-tat TW M T5 F5

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This is an easy/moderate 23.1km through walk with 17.1kms of track, 6 kms of off track over two days and one of our favourite adventures.

Leaving O'Reilly car park we take the border track to Echo Point. From the campsite we head Westward on a faint walking pad towards Rat-a-Tat. Along the way tree falls may obscure the track and need to be negotiated through wait-a-while and other prickly plants.

We ascend Mt Worendo and then drop to a saddle and then up again to Mt Wapawn. About 800m further along the track levels out and we look out for a tin lid hanging in a tree which marks the track and the steep drop down to the Rat-a-tat bush campsite.

Careful navigation is necessary in the off track area and negotiating this section can take longer than expected.

Tat-a-tat is a beautiful, shady but small campsite with a rocky creek for water collection and glow worms shining at night.

Sunday morning we return via the same route.
