The following information is from the organizers, John and Lyn Daly –

“We have contacted the rangers at Main Range to make sure there are no park alerts and all is OK. Some people intend to arrive on the Friday afternoon / evening.

On Saturday we intend doing a walk to the Slot in the Wall. It used to be the Hole in the Wall but the top of the hole collapsed. It's an off-track walk but the route is fairly well-defined. There are stunning views all along the Main Range Ramparts and to Boars Head and Mt Castle. There is the option for some people to turn around from the head of Laidley Falls where there are also great views. We will need to drive a few kilometres uphill from the campsite to the start of the walk. It's not a 4WD road but we will need to use high clearance vehicles. It's only about a 6 km return walk but may take a while with a group.

On Sunday, there are a few options for easy to moderate half-day track walks so anyone who wants to leave after lunch can get back home at a reasonable time. The Cascades Circuit is around 6.5 km, with several creek crossings and ambling along will take about 3 hours. For those wanting a longer walk we will join on the Ridge Track, a steeper circuit, probably an extra 5 km, adding around an extra 2.5 hours with a group. We start and finish at the campground.

This will be a good chance for people to get together and meet a few new walking friends.”
